2nd Installment due: **October 26th, 2018**

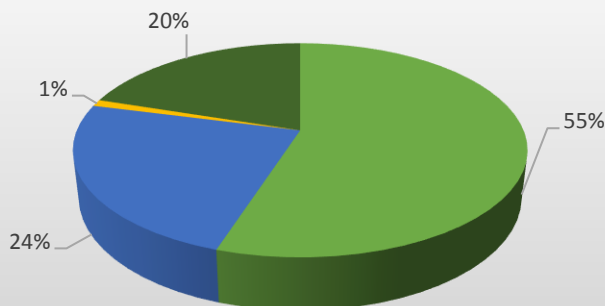
2018 Budget

Roads: The Roads department will be undertaking preliminary efforts in 2018 to address the Forest Lake Road “Bump” just east of the Township office. This will include removal of the surface treatment, followed by an application of gravel. Further construction needs will be determined at a later date. Gravel has been applied to Paisley Road and a portion of Forest Lake Road.

Thank you for your patience and please drive carefully during construction.

Taxation: The 2018 budget represents an average overall increase of 0.8% in taxation.

■ Taxation - 55% ■ Grants & Funding - 24% ■ Licences & Permits - 1% ■ Other Revenue - 20%

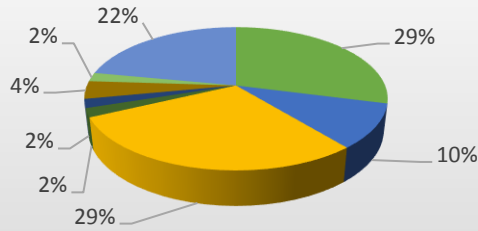
Taxation: General municipal taxation
