**2018 Municipal Election: Monday October 22, 2018**

**Voting Method:** The election method for the 2018 Municipal Election in the Township of Joly will be Vote by Mail.

**Nomination Period:** The nomination period for the 2018 Municipal Election will open May 1, 2018 and will close at 2:00 p.m. on July 27, 2018.

**2018 Fees & Permits**

**2018 Dog Tags & Kennel Licenses are now due.** Please visit us at 871 Forest Lake Rd to pay your fees and receive your tag(s).

**2018 Trailer Permit Fees are now due.** Please forward payment to the Municipal office to have your permit issued. If you are applying for a new trailer permit, please complete the application form with payment for approval. If you are renewing a trailer permit, please complete the renewal form with payment.

**Driveway permits and Civic Address Signs (911 number)** Please contact the municipal office to complete a driveway permit application or to request a Civic Address Sign for your property. Applicable fees will apply.

**Fire Permits** From April 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>, all open-air burning requires a permit. Incinerator permits are also available.

**Building Department** – contact Brian Dumas or Tyler Irwin at (705) 384-9444. A building permit or demolition permit must be obtained if you are constructing or demolishing buildings in Joly Township. If you are not sure when a permit is required, please call the building department.

**Emergency Preparedness** – Are you and your family prepared for possible emergencies? A 72 hour emergency kit can ensure that you can meet the special needs of all household members including children and pets if you have to stay home up to 72 hours due to an emergency. The spring melt presents flood risks and residents are reminded to listen for severe weather warnings on local radio or television and check the MNR Flood advisory website.

**Fire Safety & Prevention** – Do you have a fire safety plan for your home, cottage, trailer or work place? It is an important tool in fire safety. When everyone knows what to do in the event of a fire, they will be calm and able to move to a safe place quickly. Check your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms monthly. It is recommended to change the batteries with each daylight savings time change in the spring and fall.

Joly Township maintains service agreements with both the Sundridge Strong Fire Department and the South River Machar Fire Department to ensure that both departments are prepared to respond to service calls for Joly residents as required. See page 3 for the Fire Rating chart and watch for changes to the Fire Rating signs as you enter Joly Township from Sundridge and South River.

<b>MODERATE</b>	<p><b>NO DAYTIME BURNING ALLOWED</b></p> <p>Open Air Burning and Incinerators, including burn barrels with 3/8" mesh as lid allowed starting at 6pm and completely out by 10am.</p> <p>Only environmentally friendly products may be burned.</p> <p>Camp fires are allowed for cooking and warmth at any time.</p>
<b>HIGH</b>	<p><b>NO DAYTIME BURNING ALLOWED</b></p> <p><b>NO OPEN BURNING – NO FIREWORKS</b></p> <p><b>Only</b> enclosed camp fires for cooking and warmth.</p> <p>Enclosed fire, surrounded by brick/stones or in metal burn container/ring no bigger than 2 feet/24 inches.</p>
<b>EXTREME</b>	<p><b>COMPLETE FIRE BAN</b></p> <p><b>NO BURNING ALLOWED at any time.</b></p> <p><b>NO FIREWORKS</b></p>

**Important!** Fire permits are required from April 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> for all open air burning. An incinerator permit can be purchased for \$50.00 and is for the entire season, except during a fire ban. All other open air burning permits are \$10.00 and are issued for no more than 3 days. All permits must be purchased at the municipal office prior to any open air burning.
