

## Council Member's Declaration of Pecuniary Interest

Pursuant to Subsection 5.1, if the Municipal Conflict of Interest Act, R.S.O. 1990 (in force and effect on March 1, 2019), Council members must complete this form prior to the Council meeting at which they will be making a declaration of pecuniary interest, direct or indirect.
