Whereas the Village of Sundridge, the Township of Strong and the Township of Joly are 'the Community Sponsor' of the Rural and Northern Physician Group Agreement (RNPGA) for the Sundridge & District Medical Centre, and; Whereas the Community Sponsor is responsible to assist with any necessary Physician Recruitment, and:

Whereas Item 4.4 of the Tri-Council Meeting held on May 30, 2019 was to discuss Physician Recruitment Initiatives for the impending vacancy in the Group Physician arrangement,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Township of Joly hereby agrees to:

- A Completion bonus of \$ 25,000 to be paid upon hiring; and
- Relocation expense to a maximum of \$ 5,000;

with the Township of Joly paying 10% of these recruitment incentives. Carried
